This region is famous for its photogenic landscapes, scenic hot air balloon trips, underground cities, cave churches, and houses carved directly into the rock. This historical region attracts crowds year-round from all over the world.

DAY 2 - ISTANBUL CITY TOUR

Experience Istanbul's timeless sights on a full-day tour of the city's stunning historic places.

Spot the distinctive tiles of the Blue Mosque. See the Byzantine mosaics and minarets of Hagia Sophia, then follow in the footsteps of powerful sultans, courtiers, and generals at Topkapi Palace. We will finish our tour in the vibrant Grand Bazaar, browsing bright displays of handicrafts, carpets, and souvenirs.

DAY 3 - ISTANBUL CITY TOUR (part II)

Today after breakfast, we will see the Egyptian Spice Market, visit Turkism Square, and cruise along the Bosphorus and the Golden Horn waters. View the Asian and European sides of Istanbul and admire the palaces, wooden villas, bridges, and unique maritime landscapes.

DAY 6 - HOT AIR BALLOON FLIGHT

Today we will be picked up from the hotel for an early morning 1-hour hot balloon flight. We will participate in one of Turkey's most famous tourist attractions, soaring above the city's beautiful Stoney landscapes.

After landing, we will head back to our hotel for breakfast.

Later that morning, we will depart for the Cappadocia tour, visiting Kaymakli Underground City, Sobesos Roman Bath, Taskinpasa Madrasah, and Mustafapasa - Sinasos.

DAY 7 - TRANSFER BACK TO ISTANBUL

In the morning, we will depart our hotel in Cappadocia and transfer to the airport for a flight to Istanbul. Upon arrival in Istanbul, we will be transferred to our hotel near the airport.

What's Included:

4-Star Accommodations - All booking includes standard single and double rooms. Each room has (1) queen or (2) twin beds and private bathrooms. Accommodation details are provided 4-6 weeks before trip departure.

Hagia Sophia - (Ayasofya, Santa Sophia), Built in the 6th century by Emperor Justinian, played a significant role in the Christian and Islamic World.

Blue Mosque - Built in the early 1600s for Sultan Ahmet I of the Ottoman Empire, the Blue Mosque is truly a magnificent masterpiece of architecture.

Topkapi Palace - Topkapi Palace is an excellent monument of Oriental architecture that resembles the power of the Ottoman Empire.

Grand Bazaar - (Kapali Carsi) One of the world's largest and oldest covered markets with over 4,000 shops with colorful products of ceramic, leather, rugs, carpets, handicrafts, clothes, and gold.

Spice Market - a colorful indoor bazaar with many shops offering various spices, purses, flavored teas, Turkish delights, nuts, ceramics, and small souvenirs.

Bosphorus Cruise - Take the public ferry for Bosphorus Cruise to see Istanbul's European and Asian sides, Galata Tower, Dolmabahce Palace, Beylerbeyi Palace, the Rumeli Fortress, old Ottoman villas, Bosphorus bridges, and mosques.

Taksim Square - Taksim square is a great place defining modern Turkey, which witnessed critical historical moments.

Domestic Flight - Round Trip flight from Istanbul to Cappadocia

Uchisar Castle - Uchisar Castle is located in Uchisar and stands proudly as the highest point in Cappadocia.

Hot Air Balloon Flight - Soar over Cappadocia while participating in one of the region's most popular tourist attractions.

Goreme Open Air Museum- Visit the Unesco World Heritage site museums, which contain the remains of many churches carved into the famous Cappadocia stone.

Meals - Breakfast is provided daily. Meals outlined in the itinerary include (1) bottle of water.

Airport Transfers - Round trip airport transfers are provided on a tour's start and end dates.
